The Greeks invented lots of mythical beasts. Look at the pictures and see if you can work out which one was which and write in their names.


A gorgon was a woman with snakes for hair, and a grinning mouth with tusks.

Papyrus

The Ancient Egyptians invented paper. They made it from a reed called papyrus which grew in the marshes along the River Nile.

The sentences below tell the story of how papyrus was made into paper, but the order has got mixed up.

Match them with the sentences and stick them on a separate piece of paper.

The strips were laid criss-cross in a frame and beaten flat with a mallet or stone until the layers bonded together.


People went into the marshes to cut bundles of papyrus reeds.


The inside of the stems (called the pith) was cut into thin strips.


Scribes wrote in hieroglyphs on the paper, using reed pens.


The sheets of paper were lifted out and polished with a pebble.
