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# Understanding Everyday Writing

This series has been written to provide support for children with special educational needs at Key Stage 2 and into the early terms of Key Stage 3. The series is designed to help the development of the comprehension skills needed to understand the everyday texts with which children are confronted. The books may be used as part of independent or group work.

Each exercise is spread over two pages, providing differentiated material at two levels.

The first page provides a simple exercise and contains a comprehension text followed by three simple questions. The Look Again! section provides 2 extra activities to give differentiation within the page but can be removed so that less able pupils are not over-faced.

The second page provides a more difficult task and consists of a series of more searching questions. The teacher or support assistant should ensure that the children can read the comprehension passage and are also given the opportunity to discuss what they have read before answering the questions independently. In order to encourage children to read thoroughly for information, answers may be found in the title, in the page heading or in the art work.

The record chart at the back of the book provides the teacher with a checklist of the work each child has covered and the level of attainment achieved.
