The Greeks invented lots of mythical beasts. Look at the pictures and see if you can work out which one was which and write in their names.




A **gorgon** was a woman with snakes for hair, and a grinning mouth with tusks.

A **centaur** had the head and chest of a man and a horse's body.

The **Minotaur**, from Crete, had the head of a bull and the body of a man.

A **griffin** had an eagle's head and wings with the body of a lion.

A **sphinx** had a woman's head, a lion's body and wings.
